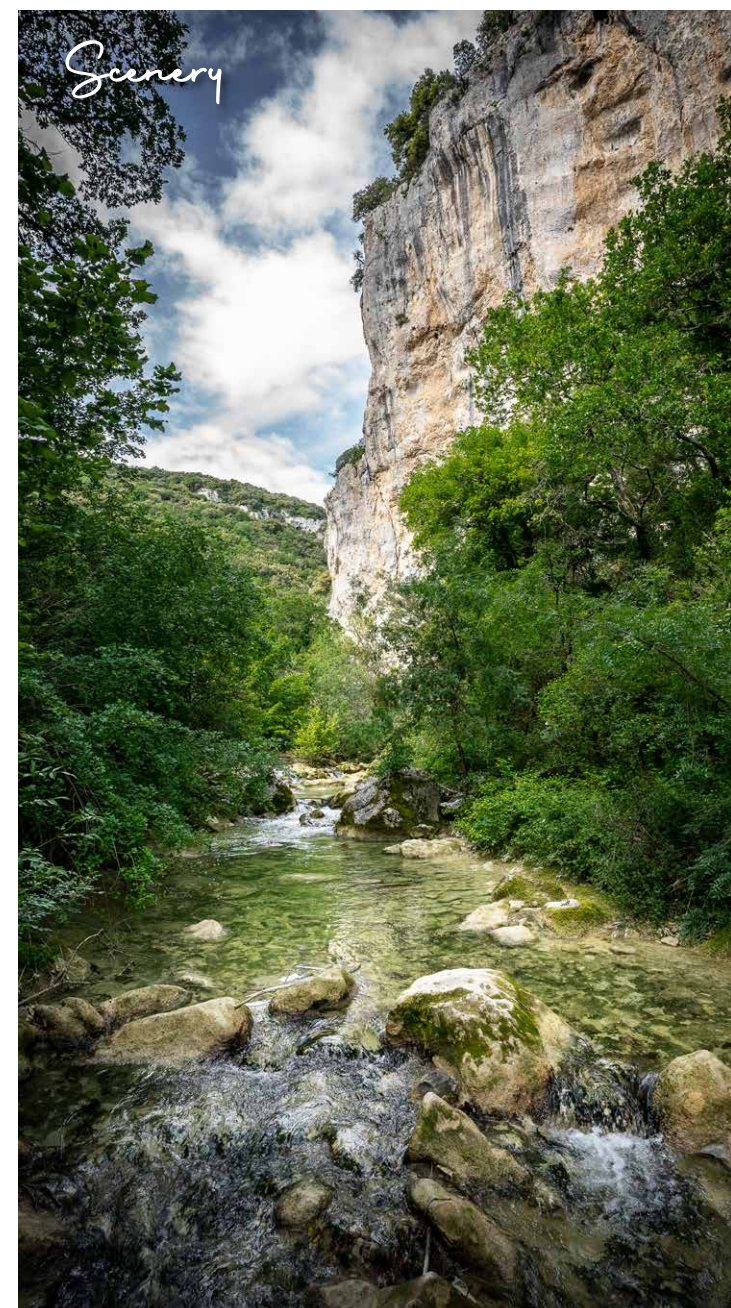

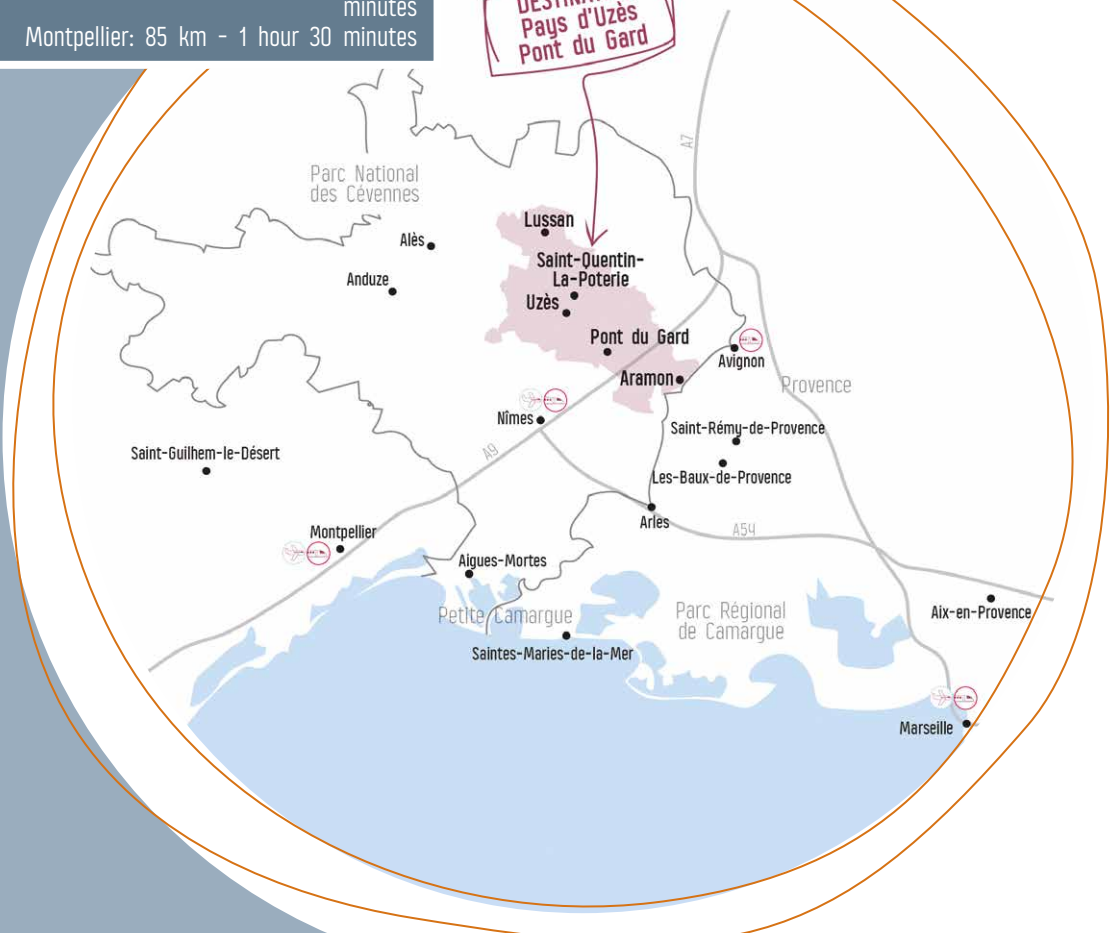

Lussan, hilltop village

Lussan is a hilltop village north of Uzès, listed as one of France's most beautiful villages. The town's narrow streets tell several centuries' worth of history, from the religious wars to silk manufacturing. Behind its ramparts, Lussan boasts a vast view of the mountains of the Cévennes, the Monts d'Ardèche and Mont Ventoux.
